



## **SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES**

### **Middle School**

#### **1. OFFICIAL UNIFORM PROVIDER**

The official uniform provider of Andersen International School is **LM SCHOOL UNIFORMS**. Therefore it is forbidden to use and copy the Andersen logo on the clothing or school bags under threat of prosecution.

#### **2. EVERYDAY UNIFORM**

Our everyday school uniform consists of:

- a blue pullover or gilet
- a white shirt or polo t-shirt
- blue trousers or Bermuda unisex shorts or a skirt or a blue dress
- a trolley school bag

All of the items listed above must be purchased from the official provider.

For the science lab, students need to wear a white apron, available from most work-wear or stationery stores

#### **3. PORTS UNIFORM**

The sports uniform is made of trousers, shorts, pinocchetto trousers or leggings, T-shirts or sweatshirts. It is only possible to wear it on the days when there is PE.

#### **4. SCHOOL TRIPS, EVENTS**

During school trips or special events where directors expressly request it, from Y1 onwards, also the following items are compulsory: scarf for girls and tie for boys.

#### **5. SHOES**

Shoes (incl. PE trainers) and socks must be blue or black and can be purchased by any retailer, including the official one.

#### **6. OTHER ITEMS**

For the science lab a white coat is compulsory, which can be bought by any provider.

#### **7. LACK OF RESPECT OF THE RULES**

Respecting the school uniform rules is part of the student's evaluation on the school report by the teachers.
