Art Club Senior - Ms Maria McGoldrick

Children create quality works of fine art using both contemporary and historical methods and materials. They develop their creativity, confidence and imagination by working in a small group to explore the visual, tactile and sensory qualities of materials and they develop an appreciation and enjoyment of visual art and design through learning about different forms of art from around the world.

Participants: Senior open to Y4 - Y9 (min No. 7, max No. 12 students)

Duration: 1 lesson a week (from 16.00 till 17.00) on Thursday

Annual cost Euros 750.00

Artistic Gymnastics - Propatria

Artistic gymnastics, an Olympic activity for both men and women, develops various skills such as strength, balance, and coordination, essential for many other sports. Lessons include warm-up and stretching followed by exercises on apparatuses like the beam and mini-trampoline to enhance motor and acrobatic abilities. The women's discipline involves performances on Olympic apparatuses and the use of preparatory tools like the mini-trampoline and tumbling, contributing to the development of a versatile motor foundation.

Participants: Open to Y2 - Y6 (min No. 6, max No.24 students)

Duration: 1 lesson a week (from 16.00 till 17.00) on Thursday

Annual cost Euros 600.00

Baby Gym - Propatria

The Baby Gym course aims to introduce children aged 3-5 to artistic and rhythmic gymnastics through a playful approach, developing their motor and coordination skills. Through technical exercises and the use of specific equipment, children learn to understand their own bodies, improve posture, and experiment with various motor actions, while also being stimulated pedagogically to express themselves and interact with others while respecting rules.

Participants: Open to KG - Y1 (min No. 6, max No.20 students)

Duration: 1 lesson a week (from 16.00 till 17.00) on Thursday

Annual cost Euros 600.00

Baby Modern Dance - Propatria

In this fun and energetic after-school club, children will explore the basics of modern dance through playful movement, music, and rhythm. They will develop coordination, balance, and body awareness while learning simple choreographies in a joyful and creative environment. The club encourages self-expression, teamwork, and a love for movement—all tailored to young learners.

MUN (Model United Nations) - Mr James Harris & Ms Susanna Grazzini **NEW**

Model United Nations club is a simulation of the procedures used by the United Nations. Students act as delegates or chairs, representing a country, different to their own, to discuss a matter of global concern as part of a specialized committee at a conference.

Collectively, students learn to negotiate, debate and develop a resolution on a topical issue. Participation in the club will enhance formal English speaking skills, critical thinking, leadership, team-work and global awareness.

Participants: Open to Y7 - Y9 (min No. 10 students)
 Duration: 1 lesson a week (from 15.50 - 16.50) on Monday
 Annual cost: Euros 650.00 + possible MUN conferences

FAQ**How do I enrol?**

1. Submit the printed enrolment form (duly completed and signed) to the NEW school office (**Open Space**). The only exception applies to new families enrolled at the school, who may also submit the form via email.
2. Simultaneously make a cash payment of €100 for each selected course as a confirmation deposit and advance payment.
A receipt will be issued upon payment.

Please note:

- priority will be given according to the order in which applications are received;
- the After-School Activities General Conditions must be read before enrolment.

The deadline for enrolment is **June 5th, 2026**.

Can I change my mind?

Yes. To cancel an enrolment, simply send an email to secretary@andersenschool.it by June 19th, 2026 and the deposit will be fully refunded.

After June 19th, 2026, the deposit will no longer be refundable, except in the cases specified in the General Conditions.

What happens next?

By the following week, you will be notified via email whether the enrolment has been confirmed.

In the event that:

- the course is cancelled (minimum number not reached), or
- the course is already full,

the school office will arrange the refund of the confirmation deposit in cash.

Apart from the above cases, the deposit will not be refunded.

How do I pay the balance?

All clubs must be paid directly to the school in a single payment by September 18th.

Only one invoice will be issued for the total amount, including the confirmation deposit.
