MUN (Model United Nations) - Mr James Harris & Ms Susanna Grazzini

Model United Nations club is a simulation of the procedures used by the United Nations. Students act as delegates or chairs, representing a country, different to their own, to discuss a matter of global concern as part of a specialized committee at a conference.

Collectively, students learn to negotiate, debate and develop a resolution on a topical issue. Participation in the club will enhance formal English speaking skills, critical thinking, leadership, team-work and global awareness.

SPANISH CLUB (for beginners) - Ms Federica Speriani

This club is designed for students with little or no previous knowledge of Spanish who would like to learn the language in a fun, relaxed, and interactive environment. Through games, role-plays, conversations, music, videos, and cultural activities, students will develop basic communication skills while gaining insight into Spanish-speaking cultures. The focus is on participation, confidence-building, and enjoyment rather than formal language learning. This is a great opportunity to explore a new language, make new friends, and discover different cultures.

Material needed: beginner-level Spanish course book

Participants: MYP and DP students who have little or no prior knowledge of Spanish (min. No. 6)
 Day/Time: 1 lesson a week - MONDAY from 15.30 till 16.30
 Annual cost: € 650,00 + optional cultural activities and certification opportunities



PHILOSOPHICAL MINDS - Ms Lucia Manzoni

Join a welcoming community of inquiry where students explore big questions through philosophy, literature, art, and current issues. Through guided discussions and shared reflection, participants develop critical thinking, communication, and argumentation skills while learning to listen respectfully to different perspectives. The club encourages creativity, independent thinking, and meaningful dialogue in a supportive environment where every voice is valued. No prior knowledge of philosophy is required - just curiosity and a willingness to think deeply.

Material needed: pen, pencil, notebook

Day/Time: 1 lesson a week - THURSDAY from 15.30 till 16.30
Annual cost: € 650,00

DRAMA CLUB - Mr Mauro Di Vincenzo

This club offers students the opportunity to explore acting, creativity, and performance in a fun and collaborative environment. Through improvisation, scriptwriting, and theatre exercises, participants develop communication skills, self-confidence, teamwork, and emotional awareness. Students will learn acting techniques, create original scenes, and work together to produce a final performance. The club is also a valuable opportunity for DP students to engage in CAS experiences and for MYP students to gain inspiration for their Personal Project.

There will be a final performance - written and created by the students.

MATHEMATICS CLUB - Mr Zain Ahmed

This club is designed for students who enjoy maths and want to challenge themselves beyond the classroom curriculum. Through logic puzzles, problem-solving activities, and competition-style questions, participants will develop analytical thinking, creativity, and confidence. The club encourages collaboration, discussion, and the exploration of different strategies for tackling complex mathematical problems.

Material needed: Mini-whiteboard and marker, stationery, calculator

Annual cost: € 650,00 + possible mathematics competitions

DEBATE CLUB - Ms Gaia Zanini

This club provides students with a supportive environment to develop public speaking, critical thinking, and argumentation skills. Through structured debates on current global issues, students learn to analyse different perspectives, build persuasive arguments, and respond confidently under pressure. The club also strengthens teamwork, active listening, leadership, and communication skills that are valuable across all academic subjects.
